COVID-19 Update

Our office is following the guidelines of the Massachusetts
Department of health and the CDC. Our website will keep up to
date postings, but feel free to check regular CDC updates here



- We kindly ask you **call us** prior to your visit if you have traveled to any of the high risk areas, currently including: China, Iran, Italy, Japan or South Korea or have had direct contact with a known COVID-19 carrier in the last 14 days
- **Do not panic!** But you can stay prepared and help prevent the spread by:
 - Wash your hands frequently for at least 20 seconds
 - Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth
 - Avoid close contact with anyone who traveled to a location listed as a high risk region
 - Stay at home if you are sick, and call us if you would like guidance on whether your child should be seen
 - Get your flu shot the flu is still a higher risk than COVID-19 in Massachusetts
